## Afrobarometer Round 7 <br> Summary of Results for Tanzania, 2017

A frobarometer is a pan-A fric an, non-partisan research network that conducts public attitude surveys on democracy, govemance, economic conditions, a nd related issues in countries across Afric a. Six rounds of surveys were conducted between 1999 and 2015, and Round 7 surveys are being caried out in 2016-2017. Afroba rometer conducts face-to-face interviews in the language of the respondent's choice with nationally representative samples of 1,200 or 2,400 respondents.

Afrobarometer is produced collaboratively by social scientists from a cross Africa. Coordination is provided by the Centerfor Democratic Development (CDD) in G hana, the Institute for J ustice and Reconciliation (IJ R) in South Africa, the Institute for Development Studies (IDS) at the University of Nairobi in Kenya, a nd the Institute for Empirical Research in Political Economy (IREEP) in Benin. Michigan State University (MSU) and the University of Cape Town (UCT) provide technical support to the network.

The Afrobarometer National Partner in Ta nzania, REPOA, interviewed a nationally representative, random, stratified probability sample of 2,400 adult Tanza nians from 30 April to 17 J une. A sample of this size yields country-level results with a margin of error of $H-2 \%$ at a $95 \%$ confid ence level. Previous surveys have been conducted in Tanza nia in 2001, 2003, 2005, 2008, 2012, and 2014. The Institute for Development Studies at the University of Nairobi provided technical backstopping for the survey. Technical details of the survey, including descriptions of stratific ation and household selection, translation languages, and related information, can be found in the survey Technical Information Form that follows.

Below is an outline of the survey findings from all the questions posed to respondents. We also present the findings by some critical demographicssuch asgender and place of residence (urban-rural).
